


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ABOUT HITS THEATRE

Since its founding in 1980 by Carolyn Franklin, HITS Theatre's goal has been to empower youth with educational theater classes in acting, singing, dancing, and production. Today, HITS is one of the leading organizations in the Houston metropolitan area that provides comprehensive musical theater training year-round for grades K-12. Group classes and coaching in all aspects of the performing arts culminate in various productions each semester at HITS' home theater located in the historic Houston Heights and at its annual production at Miller Outdoor Theatre. The HITS experience is transformational for children. Through our compassionate approach, students become disciplined team players, creative thinkers, and confident communicators – critical skills whether on stage or in the boardroom.

In 1987, HITS began a much-loved tradition of producing an annual free-to-the-public Broadway-style musical at Miller Outdoor Theatre. The professional-level presentations feature some of Houston's most talented youth. HITS took its mission outside the walls of its Heights theater and, through a partnership with the Houston Independent School District, founded a school-based theater initiative. The reason for this initiative was simple: supplementing the academics of community schools with much needed performing arts curriculum. Past partnerships include Hogg Middle School, Helms Elementary, YES Prep, Briargrove Elementary, Clifton Middle School, Harvard Elementary, River Oaks Elementary, Arabic Immersion Magnet School, The Fay School and Duchesne Academy of the Sacred Heart. addition, we have local partnerships with C.A.S.E for Kids, City Connections with the City of Houston, and Children's Initiative After School Pro-gram (CIASP). By focusing on language arts, theater training, and performance technique, these programs allow HITS to broaden the scope of its mission to inspire children through the power of theater. Our most in-depth school partnerships is with Field Elementary just down the street from our theater. Over three years, our in-school programing expanded from 3rd grade theater classes to grades 3-5, and this fall we plan to serve K-5 thanks to continued support from the Cynthia Mitchell Foundation.

HITS programs serve more than 1,000 children each year. HITS offers accessibility to a performing arts education, regardless of financial status, by providing full or partial scholarships to an average of 75 percent of our financial-aid applicants. Because tuition covers only 40 percent of our annual budget, the theater relies on the generosity of corporate sponsors, family and private foundations, public funding agencies, and individuals and families. Thank you to all of our donors for their ongoing commitment to our mission, sharing this experience with us, and believing in what we do!




