Once again, she's joining forces with Mrs Whatsit, Charles Wallace, Calvin O'Keefe and more to battle the forces of evil so she can rescue her father, save humanity and find herself. In the end, we know two things for sure: 1. Love CAN overcome evil and 2. There IS such a thing as a tesseract. Perfect for schools and touring groups, this one-act adaptation of the beloved novel masterfully retells the story in a fresh and enduring way.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

At the heart of *A Wrinkle in Time* is a simple but powerful truth: love triumphs over hate. In a universe threatened by fear and conformity, it is not perfection that saves the day—it is the brave, imperfect choice to love.

Meg's journey reminds us that the very things that make us different are often our greatest strengths. Where hate demands sameness, love celebrates individuality and lights the way forward to a better future.

We chose this play for our Topsy Turvy season because the Murry's world gets flipped on its head and they come out as a stronger family with new friends and new adventures for the rest of their lives. The power of love is their compass and even when they are transported millions of lightyears away, love is what guides them home.

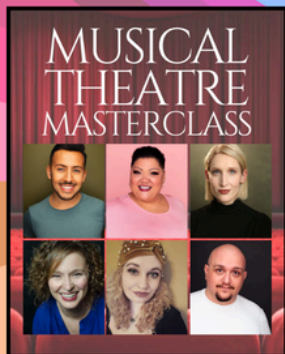
